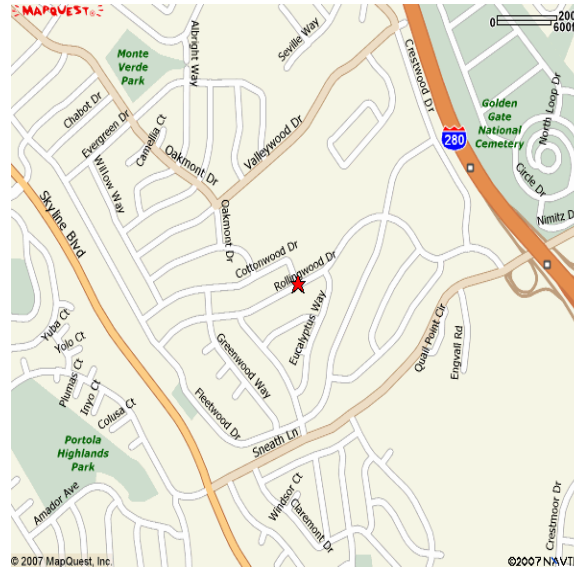


Vision Statement

Our School Program

Rollingwood School has a very dedicated, fully credentialed teaching staff devoted to providing a standards-based curriculum for all children. Staff members collaborate regularly to meet the academic, physical, social, and emotional needs of all students.

The San Bruno Park School District values small class sizes in grades K-3 with a 20:1 student to teacher ratio average. In grades 4-6, the average ratio is 29:1 depending on enrollment for that year.

Rollingwood School has established a character education program called "Rollingwood Families". This program groups students into mixed grade level school families with the 6th grade student as the family leader. During family time, students practice and learn skills for character education.



Demographics

The student population at Rollingwood is 250 kindergarten through 6th grade students. Currently, there are 11 general education classroom teachers, two special day class teachers, a special educator, physical educator and music teacher through a partial district and PTA contract with Rhythm and Moves, a speech therapist, instructional aide for the computer lab, and a dedicated support staff. Rollingwood has a very diverse student population with over 8 languages represented and many more cultures.



Student Activities

Rollingwood offers many exciting enrichment activities for students throughout the school year. We have student broadcasters report school events, birthdays, lunch menu, and news on Rollingwood Radio every morning. Students can join the Mileage Club during lunch to run or walk a mile on the playground. Other activities include the Rollingwood Chronicle student newspaper, Garden Club, Student Council, and Green Team for recycling. During the school year, students have ample opportunity to enrich their education through classroom and school activities.



Library

Students in all grades visit the library weekly to learn library skills, do research and select books for independent reading. The PTA generously donates funds every year to help support the purchase of new books and reference materials. The library is efficiently maintained by our media aide.

Technology

In the library, we have a media center with desktop computers and two laptop carts. The school is now wireless too! Classrooms for grades 2-6 each have 5-7 desktop computers for student use as well as the laptop cart and grades K and 1 each have 2 computers. Teachers also use LCD projectors with laptop computers for multimedia lessons.



Before and After School Programs

For a fee, students can attend several activities offered by the San Bruno Park and Recreation. We also have an onsite daycare provider called Happy Hall for working families. Information about these programs and fees is available in the school office.

Getting Involved

Rollingwood has a very involved Parent Teacher Association. There are many ways a person can get involved by volunteering for class library visits, computer lab, yard duty, and PTA events like the Carnival, Founder's Day, Spaghetti Dinner, Walkathon, and Pancake Breakfast. These positions are available for sign-up on the first day of school gathering for parents in the cafeteria and throughout the year. Our children enjoy seeing their parents at school!
